

The Schuylkill County Alternative Dispute Resolution Program

The Schuylkill County Bar Association has established an Alternative Dispute Resolution (“ADR”) Program to assist litigants and their counsel in resolving all forms of civil matters which may be filed or are currently pending in the Court of Common Pleas of Schuylkill County. Specifically, the Bar Association’s ADR Program affords litigants and their counsel an opportunity to resolve matters through non-binding mediation or binding arbitration. Binding arbitrations may be held before a single arbitrator or panel or arbitrators, and may incorporate any format which the litigants and their counsel agree to.

There are currently over 30 members of the Schuylkill County Bar Association who have offered their services as mediators and arbitrators. The Bar Association members who are available to mediate or arbitrate matters have extensive experience in various areas of the law. C.V.’s are available for the mediators and arbitrators through the Court Administrator’s Office, the Prothonotary’s Office and the Schuylkill County Law Library.
