2012 GENERAL ELECTION IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER

- October 9 Last day to register to be eligible to vote at the ensuing November Election.
- October 30 Last day before the Election absentee ballot application for civilian absentee ballots shall be received in the office of the County Board of Elections at any time prior to 5 o'clock PM from certain persons.
- November 2 All absentee ballots, except those received from military and overseas electors as defined by sections 1301 (a) to (h) of the Pennsylvania Election Code, and those received emergency absentee electors who become ill or are called away from home after 5 o'clock PM on this day, must be received by the County Board of Elections not later than 5 o'clock PM on this day to be counted.
- November 6 General Election – Polls to remain open continuously between the hours of 7 o'clock AM to 8 o'clock PM.

THE COURT'S ORDER EFFECTIVELY PROVIDED FOR ANOTHER "SOFT ROLLOUT" FOR THE NOVEMBER ELECTION. ALL VOTERS MUST BE ASKED TO SHOW PROOF OF IDENTIFICATION, BUT THEY WILL NOT BE REQUIRED TO VOTE BY PROVISIONAL BALLOT IN THE EVENT THAT THEY DO NOT SHOW PROOF OF IDENTIFICATION.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE "FIRST-TIME VOTER" REQUIREMENTS THAT WERE IN PLACE PRIOR TO SEPTEMBER 17, 2012 WILL APPLY IN THE NOVEMBER 6 GENERAL ELECTION. THEREFORE, THOSE VOTERS WHO ARE REQUIRED UNDER THE HELP AMERICA VOTE ACT AND/OR THE PENNSYLVANIA ELECTION CODE TO PROVIDE IDENTIFICATION WILL STILL BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE IDENTIFICATION AT THE NOVEMBER 6 GENERAL ELECTION.
