Pennsylvania Tax Officer Bond

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the CENTRAL TAX BUREAU OF PENNSYLVANIA, INC., as Principal, and TRAVELERS CASUALTY AND SURETY COMPANY OF AMERICA, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Connecticut and authorized to do business in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as Surety, are held and firmly bound unto the SCHUYLKILL COUNTY TAX COLLECTION COMMITTEE (the "TCC"), as Obligee, in the penal sum of Two Million One Hundred Two Thousand Three Hundred Ten Dollars (\$2,102,310.00) for the payment of which well and truly to be made, they bind themselves, their successors and assigns, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

Whereas, the Principal has entered into an agreement with the TCC to serve as the Tax Officer (as defined under 53 P.S. § 6924.501) for the Schuylkill County Tax Collection District (the "Tax Collection Agreement"); and

Whereas, pursuant to the Tax Collection Agreement and 53 P.S. § 6924.509(d), the Principal is required to post a Bond guaranteeing its faithful performance as a Tax Officer;

NOW, THEREFORE, the conditions of this obligation are such, that if the Principal (or its employees or appointees) shall (i) complete the faithful execution of all duties required of the Principal in its capacity as the Tax Officer under applicable law and under the Tax Collection Agreement; (ii) complete the just and faithful accounting and payment over of all moneys and balances paid to, received or held by the Principal in its capacity as the Tax Officer in accordance with applicable law and the Tax Collection Agreement; and (iii) complete the delivery of all tax records or other official items held in right by the Principal in its capacity as the Tax Officer to the Principal's successor in office, then this obligation shall be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

In case of a breach of any conditions of this Bond by the acts or neglect of the Principal, this Bond shall be for the use of the TCC and any other political subdivision or tax collection district for which taxes shall be collected or distributed pursuant to the Tax Collection Agreement; provided, however, regardless of the number of years this Bond remains in effect or the number of claims made hereunder, in no event shall the aggregate liability of the Surety hereunder exceed the penal sum of this Bond.

Furthermore, it is agreed and understood that Surety shall not be liable hereunder for (i) such taxes as may be determined to be uncollectible pursuant to Section 4(q) of the Tax Collection Agreement; or (ii) any loss which may be sustained through the failure of any bank or banks or other depository to pay or deliver over any monies or securities deposited by, placed to the credit of, or under the control of, the Principal, whether or not such banks or depositories were or may be selected or designated by the Principal or by other persons, except to the extent such loss is sustained as the result of Principal's failure to comply with the terms and conditions of the Deposit and Investment Policy (as now or in the future in effect) attached to the Tax Collection Agreement.

This Bond shall be in effect for the term beginning on September 30, 2011, and ending six (6) months after the effective date of termination or expiration of the Tax Collection Agreement, unless earlier terminated as described herein, or unless extended by a Continuation Certificate issued by the Surety. This Bond may be terminated by the Surety at any time upon thirty (30) days advance written notice to the TCC. The Surety will not be liable hereunder for any act or omission of the Principal occurring after the effective date of termination of this Bond, but no such termination shall affect or abridge the liability of the Surety for acts or omissions of the Principal occurring during the period this Bond was in effect. Neither the termination of this Bond nor the inability of the Principal to file replacement security shall constitute a loss recoverable hereunder.

Any claim under this Bond must be made within the time provided for by the applicable statute of limitations and applicable law, and should be sent to Travelers Bond & Financial Products Claim, 385 Washington Street, Mail Code 9275-NB03F, St. Paul, MN, 55102, or to bfpclaims@travelers.com.




Dear Ms. Stehr:
