I am writing as General Counsel for Central Tax Bureau of Pennsylvania, Inc. ("CENTAX"), in relation to the Tax Collection Agreement between the Schuylkill County Tax Collection Committee ("SCTCC") dated September 13, 2010 ("Agreement"). CENTAX acknowledge receipt of your letter of March 2, 2011, and this letter is in response to your requests.

In accordance with your request and our Agreement with the SCTCC I am pleased to submit the professional qualifications for the certified public accounting firm of Schneider Downs. Attached you will please find information which addresses the requirements of Section 4.c. (5)(iii) of the Agreement "*CPA Background Information*". I trust you find their response is complete and illustrates their professional status, superior qualifications, and recognition both regionally and nationally. With reference to the status of the acquisition of tax records for the Taxing Authorities which comprise the SCTCC, please be advised that a comprehensive Transition Plan Packet was issued to each Taxing Authority in accordance with Act 32. Included in the Transition Plan Packet was a letter outlining the Transition Plan Packet intent, Schuylkill County Transition Plan, Checklist of items to Return to CENTAX, Request for Local Services Contract, ACT 32 Information Request Sheet, ACH Authorization, and State List Request.


We provided the "ACT 32 Information Request" Questionnaire to obtain information regarding the contact information for the Taxing Authority, as well as other information necessary for contract administration and the status of their current records. We also provided to each Taxing Authority the option of selecting CENTAX as the Local

Services Tax Officer for 2012 and succeeding years. Finally, we recognize that there is one other tax collector serving Schuylkill County for the prior periods, and will reach out directly to them in an effort to acquire the data and establish accelerated timelines for record transition. Because we have transitioned hundreds of political subdivisions from this collector in the past, we are confident we will have no difficulties with record transition and success in the SCTCC. I have attached a PDF of the complete communications submitted the Taxing Authorities.

I trust you find our response to your inquiries to be satisfactory. In the coming months we will be communicating more often with the Taxing Authorities and your office to safeguard that all of the materials required for contract administration and tax collection and enforcement are received.
